- Schedules have been updated on the website and BMLT. There are new schedules available. PLEASE spread the word that ALL OLD SCHEDULES need to be replaced with the updated ones. The old schedules have the help-line number that is no longer in service. The date on the schedule must be on or after 3/13/2022.
- We have reached out to local advertising agencies regarding billboards. Currently, we several different options. LAMAR has a preemptable digital program. This program allows us to purchase an unsold spot for a digital poster at a discounted non-profit rate of \$600.00 per month. Once that spot is sold to a full price paying customer, the digital poster will be bumped to another location in Columbia. That would allow the message to be seen all over the Columbia area, instead of just one location. GRACE OUTDOORS has several different locations and rates available for different size billboards. Initial production costs range from \$700.00 to \$1,200.00. That includes the first month as well. After that, the rates range from \$300.00 to \$900.00 per month depending on the location. COMET has bus stop ads available for \$450.00 per month. If purchased for the entire year, it is \$400.00 per month. I have attached a copy of the pricing and programs to this report, and will pass them around. Please discuss these options with your homegroup, and let us know next month.

Sorry about the delay in getting this map to you. Attached is a map of all the digitals that we have in the Columbia area.

If there is a board in particular that you are interested in I can provide a non-profit specific rate for it that would guarantee you that slot, but a program that we have that might be of interest is our preemptable digital program. With that, you buy a slot on a digital at below market rate (this preemptable rate is \$600 for digital posters and \$800 for digital bulletins, when some of our digitals go for \$3000!) but when that slot is sold to a full rate paying customer you get bumped to another digital in Columbia. I feel like this program could be good for your message since it would travel all over Columbia. Also, if you are interested in static I can provide a sampling of what we have available, just let me know what dates you are interested in.

Also, a question about the art. Would you put it together or would you use our artist (included for free with your contract). If you are going to make it I can provide you the templates that will match the size boards you are interested in.
