Steering Committee Reports:

Chair: Thanked the previous steering committee. Expressed gratitude to the homegroups and the goal of adhering to policy, being efficient, timely and purposeful. Wishes to solidify our non-profit status, consolidate area's records, complete inventory of our storage space and service body, reconnect NA homegroups to area and digitize area records. (Full report attached)

Vice Chair: Expressed gratitude in being able to serve. Has been in contact with the steering committee on determining how to best serve the still sick and suffering addict. Wishes to re-establish our non-profit status and ensure area meetings are run efficiently. States that if we keep in mind that area is the place to support and service, while following policy, we should be able to better service.

Secretary: Explained that in order to adhere to policies, it requires the secretary to maintain a list of representatives and asks that this information be provided on the sheet passed around. Also, made everyone aware, if not already, that homegroups not represented for 2 consecutive meetings will be removed from roll call in order to determine quorum. This does not disqualify them from membership in CCANA. Due to this, New Beginnings was removed from the roll.

Also, asked GSRs to provide announcements on the announcements sheet available for better efficiency. (Full report attached)

Treasurer: Due to the change in standards at Wells Fargo, the signers on the bank account weren't able to be switched over. Our 501C3 nonprofit status was revoked because tax returns have not been filed in some time. We will need to partner with a CPA to file the taxes. This is ongoing and research is being conducted. The signers will be switched upon restoration of our non-profit status.

Good Afternoon,

Because we are at a financial deficit as an area, it is my goal is to personally attend the business meetings of every home group in the area, to reconnect the local NA groups that don't attend area service meetings, and to strengthen connections with the ones that do. Hopefully, our efforts to adhere to, and to amend, policy will instill confidence for the local groups to send their surplus of funds to the area itself. We need these funds to close the gap in our budget, and to hopefully create a surplus, that we can use to better carry the message to the addict who still suffers.

These are very ambitious goals, and I know that I will need help to meet them before my term is complete. I am humbly asking for that help now. I know that I am not a man who is without flaw, so I would encourage you to speak with me personally if you have concerns. I am willing to listen and reflect, and I look forward to making area meetings as great as they can be moving forward.
