- Steering Committee:
 - Chair - Patrick P.: Thanks everyone at last month's meeting for tolerating his son. Thanks Camden groups for hosting on short notice. Discussed having at least one area meeting at the Sumter & Orangeburg meeting facilities. Assures there will be certainty on the next area meeting location before leaving today.  - Activities - Dave C.: Wasn't able to attend. Hosted a lake day with good attendance. Spent \$163.20. Received \$129.00 in donations.
 - H&I - Vaughn J.: Met with the director for Orangeburg Co Alcohol & Drug Services for a possible adolescent facility commitment with a followup scheduled. Currently carrying an unofficial meeting to The Dawn Center and working on making it official. Orangeburg Co is starting a new Arise program (6 beds for men) and will be looking for a commitment located on the South Methodist College Campus. Meeting with the new director at Waypoint 09/09/2024 to discuss changes within the facility and has a goal for a scholarship. Looking for members to carry the message to Turbeville Correction Institution (information and application attached). Colored copies of IDs are required on the application. Having a felony won't automatically exclude anyone. Please get those in as the facility wants to run as many as possible at one time. H&I won't be at area in October. (Facilities Liaison report attached.)
 - Question arose about the direct affiliation concern between H&I and getting a scholarship. Brief discussion on cooperation vs. affiliation.
 - P&P - Nick A.: Received a 501c3 determination letter that states "If you don't file a required return or notice for 3 consecutive years, your exempt status will be automatically revoked". Filed IRS Form 990-N to satisfy the requirement. Going forward the form needs to be filed by the outgoing treasurer in between the June and July area meetings then verified by the incoming treasurer at the July ASC meeting. Completed the process of cleaning up and organizing our storage space. Currently has all area records. The next P&P business meeting will be 10/13/2024 at 2PM where Next Right Thing meets.  - PR - Chris F.: The Facilities Liaison wasn't available at last month's meeting, but will meet with them at the upcoming PR meeting. Working with the Web Committee to get the Bread Plugin installed on the website which will create a schedule that's

automatically populated by the information on the BMLT. This will streamline the process of schedule updating and editing. Once this goes live on the website, we will be printing new business cards with QR codes that take you to the schedule and the website. Business cards will be left with businesses, recovery organizations, hospitals, and first responders within the community. Getting business cards. We will be holding a "Sign Drive" on 09/29/2024 at 10AM. We will meet at the Finlay Park amphitheater. There were yard signs bought and not used from the previous PR committee and we plan to put them in the community around bus stops, businesses (with permission), and other high-visibility areas. September 8, 2024

Good Afternoon,

Thanks everyone involved in the CCANA, for tolerating the presence of my son at the last Area Business Meeting. I was unable to secure childcare for him, in a very short time frame, and I went with the tablet with headphones approach to subdue my child. Frankly, he did pretty well for a three year-old in a two to three hour adult business meeting. Your grace was appreciated.

I would also like to thank the Camden Groups for hosting us on shorter notice, due to the agreed upon facility being unable this month. The silver lining is that this is one part of the effort to have the area meeting at multiple locations throughout the CCANA geographic footprint. We have discussed the prospect of having the area meeting in Sumter and Orangeburg, to show our commitment to those parts of our area, and to thank them for the expense that they shoulder in coming to the Columbia Metropolitan Area multiple times per year. We will have certainty on where we meet next month by the end of this business meeting. The availability of the space will be clear to prevent any confusion moving forward. If your home group would like to host the area, please put forth a proposal for review at the end of this business meeting. I would also ask all GSRs to give a working telephone number to the secretary. I personally called the GSRs to inform them of the change in venue, but I was unable to call everyone due to not having those phone numbers. If such a change occurs in the future, I would like to personally call every GSR to inform them myself.

I would like to give an update on the progress of the "wish list of things" to accomplish during my term. We have solidified our non-profit status, and submitted a tax return as a non-profit entity. This would have not been accomplished if not for the considerable labor and attention of the Policy and Procedures Chair, Nick A. He has also been working with myself, and the Area Treasurer to complete the transfer of the area's financial accounts to the Steering Committee Members. I have been successfully added to the account, and this coming Wednesday at 3 PM, we will be going to the bank again, with Nick, to hopefully add the Area Treasurer Jay N., to the account. When all the committee members are added to the account, we will begin following the area's already existing double signature check policy to insure proper distribution of area funds. Nick A. has completed the process of cleaning up, and organizing, our storage space, and currently has possession of all area records. He is attempting to find the last copy of our area policy that is supported by documented amendments. We are starting the process of considering what a financial expense the digitization those records would entail. We have already secured a location for, and scheduled for the inventory of our area service body. This will occur on Sunday November 24th, at 3 PM. I would humbly ask that you mark your calendars and attend. This is the first inventory in over two and a half decades, and hopefully the beginning of a yearly routine. The audit of the area financial records is currently being carried out via the established ad hoc committee and we anticipate their report. I would like to point out that we continue to be at a financial deficit as an area. We continue to reach out to the local home groups to encourage donations.

Treasurer's Report 09/08/2024

As of today, QuickBooks balance is \$5,837.82. The Wells Fargo account is currently unable to be accessed online, but this issue will be rectified on 09/11/2024 at 3pm. A screenshot of the checking account balance has been provided in lieu of bank statements for the month. Two months of bank statements will be provided in the upcoming October Atea Meeting. The good news is the account is still linked and is reflecting credits and debits. The expenditures that reflected this month were \$357 to Nick (William) Agostas for the painstaking work he has done with the IRS to update our non-profit status. Chris Fite received \$58.32 for the printing of Schedules. Heather Fite was reimbursed \$274.61 for website related expenditures. Total Expenditures was \$689.93. Total Revenue (Donations) was \$68.18. As of today, the Intuit (QB) charge has not yet posted. I briefly had to collaborate with the previous Treasurer because when the bank account was re-linked to QuickBooks, several charges that occurred during her tenure (and mine) automatically were duplicated. The double entries were deleted, and the QuickBooks account has been rectified. Lastly, per request, a Statement of Activity for 2 fiscal years has

been provided to reflect all Donations (HG) for the last 2 years. Thank you for your patience, as we have been moving as fast as possible to rectify everything with the IRS (Non Profit Status) and Wells Fargo. A special thanks goes out to, Nick Agostas, as he has helped in this matter immensely. Thank you for allowing me to serve as your Treasurer.


